YEAF- Youth Education Assistance Fund for Post-Secondary

Students in care can apply once a year, up to a maximum of four years or until you turn 24. The money you receive can be used for tuition, books or living expenses. This is a non-refundable, taxable grant. You will get a T4A form for your taxes. You can apply and receive funds at any time during the education year...The YEAF endowment fund is made possible by a partnership between the Ministry of Children and Family Development, the [Ministry of Advanced Education](#) and the [Victoria Foundation](#)" (<http://www.mcf.gov.bc.ca/yeaf/>).
